To sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unloading or navigation any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds, which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits in connection with the entry of merchandise; To sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unloading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor; and generally to transact at the customhouses in said district any and all customs business,

including making, signing, and filing of protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 in or performed by an agent and attorney, giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything, whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents; the foregoing power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until the _____ day of _____, 20__ __, or until notice of revocation in writing is duly given to and received by a District Director of Customs of the district aforesaid.
